



## **Construction and Concrete**

- Amount of concrete: 32,000 m<sup>3</sup>, weighing 80,000 tonnes (enough to pour 127 km of sidewalk)
- Most concrete poured in one day: 1,200 m<sup>3</sup> (200 truckloads)
- Average angle of walls: 11 degrees (from 3 to 31 degrees)
- Construction hours (estimated total for project): 1.25 million
- Construction workers on-site at peak time: 350 to 400
- Amount of reinforcing steel (rebar): 3,750 tonnes
- Hours to build and strip forms: approx. 180,000

- Size of building: 40,860 m<sup>2</sup>
- Height at peak of building: 24.5 m
