- Information required at the time of booking: date, time of visit, number of participants, name of group, mailing address, telephone and fax numbers, credit card number and expiry date.
- We recommend booking at least three weeks prior to the visit.
- The booking contract must be signed within five business days.
- A minimum of 20 people is required for IMAX film presentations outside of the regular IMAX schedule.
- The Canadian Children's Museum can be very busy, therefore, it is highly recommended to reserve a time slot. If attendance is high, groups without a reservation may not be permitted access. We require that adult group leaders remain with children at all times.

CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS

- There is no charge for cancellations due to transportation issues related to inclement weather.
- The Museums must be informed in writing of changes or cancellations, at least **14 days** prior to your visit. Otherwise, the total cost of the booking will be charged to the credit card provided when the booking was made.

PAYMENT

- Payment may be made in cash, by credit card (Visa, MasterCard or Amex), by traveller's cheque, or by cheque made payable to the Canadian Museum of History Corporation (please indicate the reservation number on the cheque).

Canadian Museum of History and Canadian War Museum

- 1 adult for every 10 children/students

Note: Adult chaperones (within the obligatory ratio) pay the group student rate. Any additional adults pay the regular group adult rates.
