- Guided tours for FIT visitors or groups under 15 people are \$45 per group.
- Admission to all special exhibitions and the Canadian Children's Museum is included in the Museum general admission.

- Information required at the time of booking:
   Date, time of visit, number of participants, name of group,
   mailing address, telephone and fax numbers, credit card number and expiry date.
- We recommend booking at least three weeks prior to the visit.
- The booking contract must be signed within five business days.
- A minimum of 50 people is required for CINÉ+ film presentations outside of the regular CINÉ+ schedule.
- The Canadian Children's Museum can be very busy, therefore it is highly recommended to reserve a time slot. If attendance is high, groups without a reservation may not be permitted access. We require that adult group leaders remain with children at all times.

#### **CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS**

- The Museums must be informed in writing of changes or cancellations at least 14 days prior to your visit. Otherwise, the total cost of the booking will be charged to the credit card provided when the booking was made.
- There is no charge for cancellations due to transportation issues related to inclement weather.
