Theatrical orientation

Free – Offered from April to June 2017

This free, 15-minute introduction to the Museum's themes and galleries will highlight the human experience of war. The focus will be exclusively on First World War stories, helping to set the tone for your group's visit as we commemorate the centenary of the Battle of Vimy Ridge.
