# FROM THE COLD WAR TO THE PRESENT

### SYMBOLIC ARCHITECTURE

- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$  Angled walls remind us of the instability of war.
- Windows depict the words "Lest we forget" and "N'oublions jamais" in Morse code.
- The building emerges slowly from the landscape, reminding us of nature's ability to recover from the devastation of war and human conflict.
