# LEGION HALLS

A TRAVELLING EXHIBITION PRODUCED BY THE CANADIAN WAR MUSEUM FEATURING THE ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION HALLS

This exhibition consists of 25 images by Toronto photographer Tobi Asmoucha. Her photos have documented community life across the country and capture a glimpse of the role Legion Halls play in Canadian communities today.

Functioning as community centre and social hall, Legions exist as a connection to the past, and an important part of the Canadian fabric. Legion Halls are changing along with Canada's demographics; communities that have been bound together from military beginnings are going through a metamorphosis for their own preservation.

The images capture everyday moments and events in Legion branches across Canada. Printed in black and white, they aim to capture the sense of timelessness, and the connections between past and present, experienced by Asmoucha in her Legion visits.



Tobi Asmoucha is a Toronto-based freelance photographer and photography teacher. Her work has been acknowledged with a National Magazine Award and grants from the Ontario Arts Council and the Toronto Jewish Arts Council.

## REQUIRED EXHIBITION AREA

## CONSERVATION AND SECURITY

- Relative humidity maintained between a maximum summer relative humidity of 55% and a minimum winter relative humidity of 38%.

- Human surveillance when the crates are being unloaded and loaded, as well as during installation and dismantling of the exhibition.
