

PATTERN TRANSFER INSTRUCTIONS

PREPARING TO START

Choose a fabric that isn't too stretchy or transparent. Put the fabric between your two hoops, pull it taut, and tighten the screw. I cannot stress enough that your fabric must be drum-tight before you begin. If you transfer your pattern or stitch when the fabric is loose, you will have puckering, or your designs might look wonky. Cut your fabric around the hoop, leaving about one inch all around.

To transfer the pattern, use an iPad or a phone. You can also use a computer screen.

- Turn the brightness all the way up.
- Open the pattern and put your hoop on top, using the inside of the hoop so the fabric is right against the screen (if you use the top of the hoop instead, your image may be distorted because of the space between the fabric and the screen).
- Resize the image until you are happy with its proportions in the hoop.
- If you are using a touch screen, turn on guided access (you will need to configure this in your settings first). This will keep your screen from moving around as you trace.
- Use your heat erasable or washable pen to trace the design.





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
